

## THE AWARDS

The SA Press Club Awards recognise excellence in South Australian journalism across traditional and contemporary platforms.

They've been established by the SAPC so that journalists, photographers and cartoonists can be freely judged by their peers. The club is confident the awards will become the most prestigious prizes for the industry in this state.

There are 19 categories and a Gold Award will be presented to the Journalist of the Year selected from category winners. Each category winner will receive a trophy and \$250 cash. The Gold Award recipient will receive a trophy and \$1,000 cash.

**Entries are now open and will close on 8<sup>th</sup> October 2010** with the Awards Night to be held on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> November 2010.

All entrants must complete the entry form and abide by the rules and judging criteria.

- Best News Report in Print
- Best Feature in Print (newspapers, Magazines or Online)
- Best Sports Story in Print
- Best News Photograph
- Best Sports Photograph
- Best Television News Report
- Best Television Current Affairs Report
- Best Radio News, Current Affairs or Documentary Report
- Best Sports Story in Any Medium
- Best News Story in Any Medium
- Best Community Report in Any Medium
- Best Regional or Rural Report in Any Medium
- Best Headlines – up to 3 examples
- Best Artist / Cartoonist in Any Medium (up to three pieces, covers graphics, cartoons and illustrations in digital or hand-drawn formats for any medium).
- Best Designer in Any Medium – up to three pieces for design of pages, spreads or sections in magazines, newspapers, television and websites.
- Best Columnist, Blogger or Commentator in Any Medium
- Best Series, Campaign or Investigation – up to three pieces (may have been entered in another category).
- Best Scoop of the Year.
- Best Up and Coming Journalist – up to three pieces. Journalists must have less than 5 years experience
